## Aim and objectives

Good Wood is aimed at strengthening the social dialogue in the wood sector, where companies and workers are called to face reorganization and upskilling to win the sustainability challenges.

The specific objective is to provide training and debate opportunities to social partners at local and transnational level on themes such as: environment sustainability goals, the role of social partners in “greening” the wood sector, the circular bio-economy and related companies’ needs.

The reinforcement of the social dialogue, at a national and Eu level, will support a positive management in order to reconcile the business flexibility with the safety, security and welfare of employees.



## Activities

- ▶ **A study paper** with the aim of improving the awareness on the nowadays challenges and perspectives for the wood sector.
- ▶ **Training session** both at international and national level addressed to social partners.
- ▶ **Transnational Joint training events:**
  - in Rome (Italy) in May 2019
  - in Porto (Portugal) in October 2019
  - in Sofia (Bulgaria) in February 2020
- ▶ **National Joint training events:**

Three session in each partner country: Italy, Bulgaria and Portugal in June 2019, November 2019 and May 2020.
- ▶ **Study visits** for the identification of best practices which can be transferred from a country to another and from the wood sector to other sectors.
